When 18 year-old Matt McQuiston died from a drug overdose following months of treatment, Matt's family and friends established a memorial fund to provide necessary support systems to prevent similar devastation to the lives of youth and their families.

- Individual mentoring by specially trained mentors.
- Life Skills Groups that offer participants opportunities to foster their own wellbeing.
